

Measure current ring

- 1. Select a ring that will properly fit the finger of the person who will be wearing it.
- 2. Place the ring over the circles on the right. Match the inner edge of the ring to the circle that is closest in size. This measurement refers to the internal diameter of the ring.
- 3. If the ring is between two sizes, order the larger size.

Measure your finger

The size of the fingers varies according to the time of day and the weather; For best results: 1. Measure finger size on the day and when fingers are warm. (The fingers are smaller in the morning and when they are cold.) 2. Measure the finger three or four times to avoid mistakes.

Try not to use string or paper to measure finger size, as these materials can stretch or bend and result in an inaccurate measurement.

Tips to buy the ring as a surprise

Ask friends or your partner's mother if she knows the size of her finger.

Borrow a ring from your partner (from the correct finger) and use the measurements to determine the size.
